#### COLOUR

Bright pink hue with medium intensity salmon core.

#### NOSE

Delicate floral aromas with bright notes of fresh strawberry and hints of summer fruits.

#### PALATE

A soft full palate with lovely, sweet summer and herb nettle flavours, that is balanced by a vibrant, mineral acidity with a long and generous finish.

#### VINEYARD REGION

Sourced exclusively from a small selection of vineyards within the famed, cool climate, Central Valley region of Chile - these are some of Chile's finest cool climate vineyards.

#### SOILS AND PROFILE

Vineyards are situated mostly on moderately fertile alluvial soils as well as sandy loams over decomposed granite. Some of our coastal vineyards are heavily influenced by cold Pacific currents and enjoy cool nights and afternoon breezes, giving moderate yields of highly aromatic fruit with great natural acidity.

#### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A great start to the season with rain events in winter bringing respite to the dry conditions. Crops were looking healthy as we headed into a mild summer. Some untimely summer rains demanded expert vineyard management and overall the Central Valley produced some truly superb grapes, with hallmark freshness, flavour ripeness and vibrancy.
